What is Procurement of Innovation?

Innovation Procurement happens when public procurers procure the development (PCP) or deployment (PPI) of pioneering innovative solutions to address specific mid-to-long-term public sector needs.

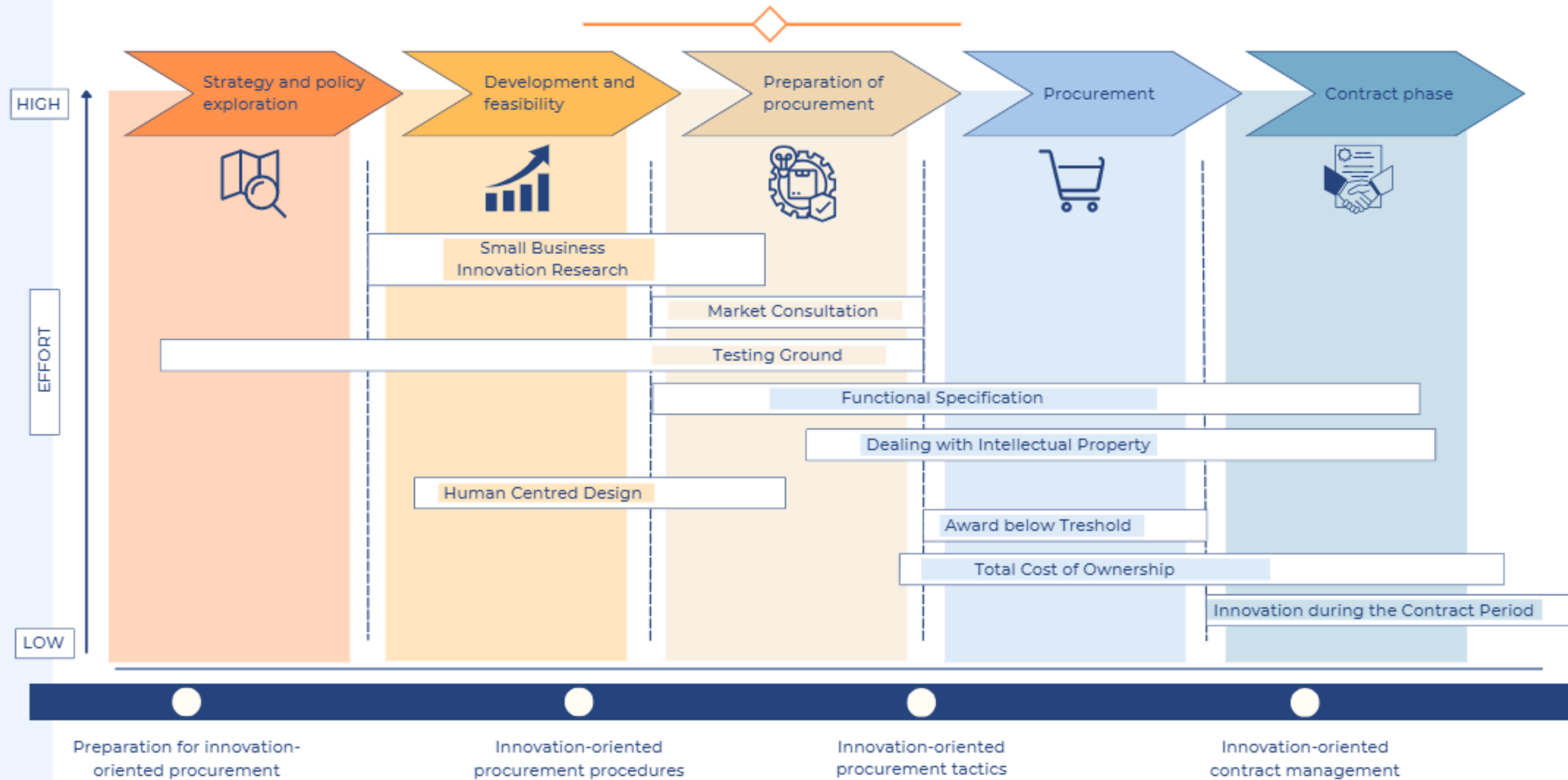

The procurement aimed for cost-efficiency and eco-friendliness.

Case

The cost of investment was **€65.000**, which produces annual cost savings of €50.000 in comparison with new computers.

CHOOSE THE FORM

What is the scope?

- Under the minimis threshold
 - Offer from 1 supplier
 - Award contract to this supplier
- Under the EU threshold
 - Possibility for direct agreement (national law)
 - Certainty that there is only 1 supplier
- Above the EU threshold
 - If there is only 1 supplier that can deliver for technical or artistic reasons and there are no reasonable alternatives or substitutes

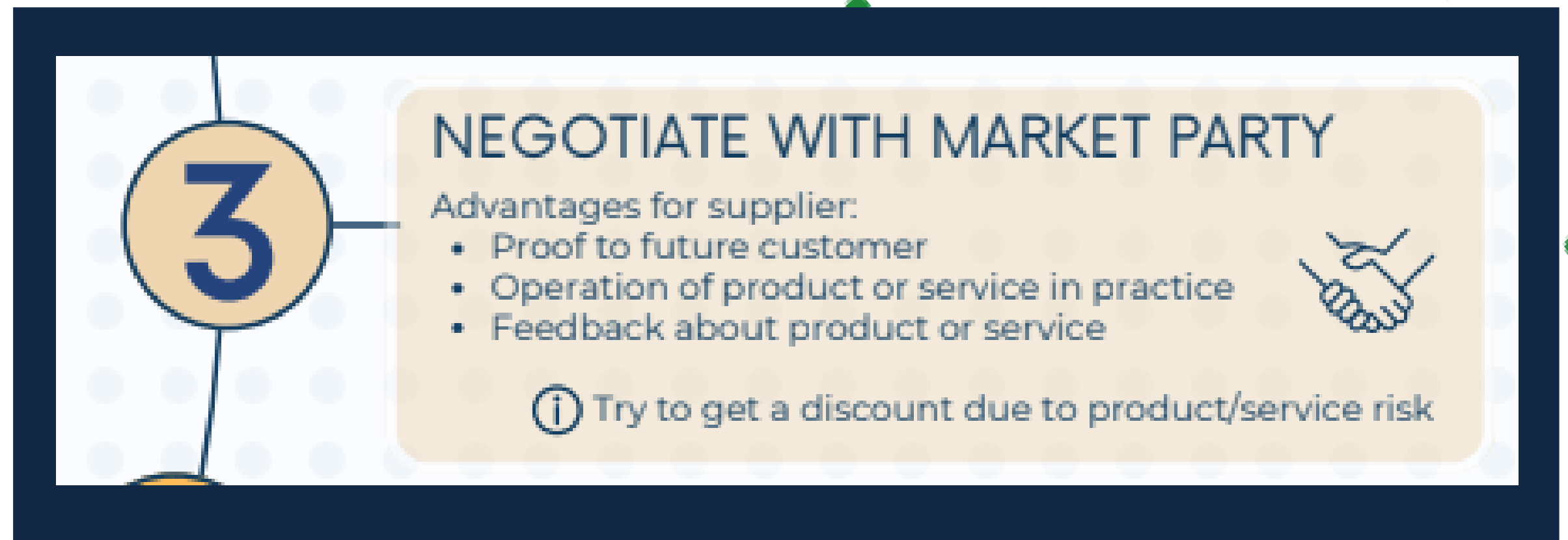

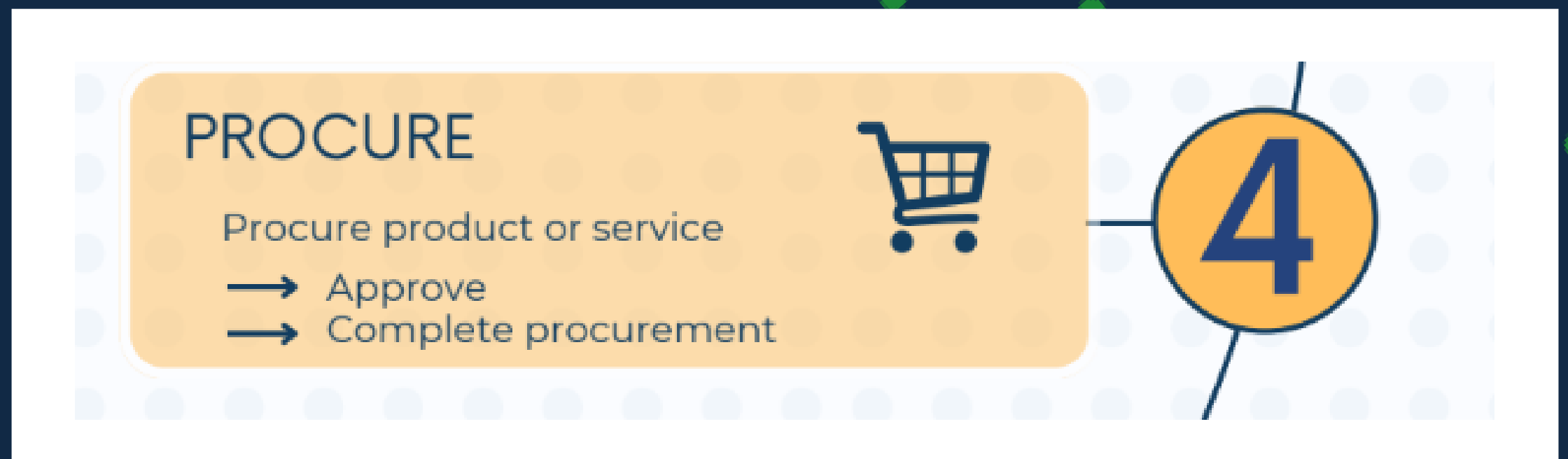

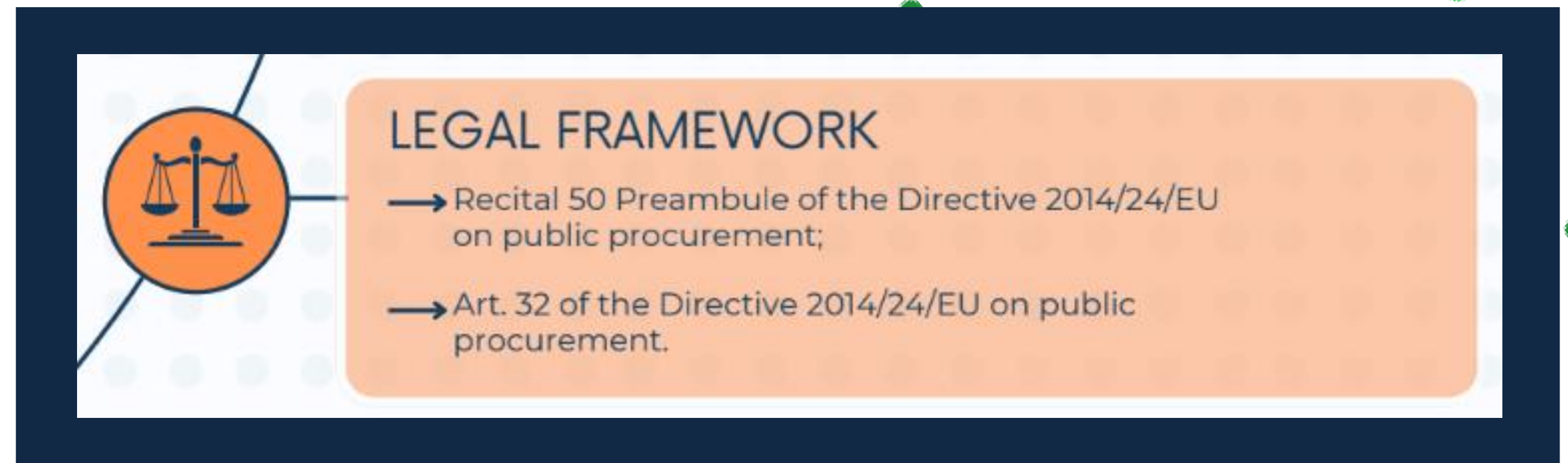
- The procurement is made for three years at a time
 - Measurable savings:
 - In 2017, 250 laptops were bought for a unit price of €250
 - In 2020, 500 devices were acquired for the same unit price.
- The reference price for a new devices was €425.



Legal Framework

Case

A negotiated procedure without prior publication may be used only in certain situations as described in Recital 50 and Art. 32 of the Directive 2014/24/EU.
